

Brisbane Central Assembly 11 April 2021

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Meeting opened 2:05pm

Welcome by Convenor, Samantha Hanrahan.

Sam read a letter from Mike Holt, who convenes the Sunshine Coast Assembly. The letter covered several topics, including:

Copyrighting your DNA

Once you've copyrighted your dna, then ask the hospital you/your children were born in for the sample they hold.

Pam has a PDF on how to ask for your Guthrie card. Fiona spoke further on this later in the meeting.

Someone asked, if someone has had the gene therapy jab, can they still copyright their dna? Nobody knows for sure. Sam directed the enquirer to our website, commonlaw.earth/downloads for the PDF.

Crypto v bullion

Mike's letter mentioned crypto-currencies and his favoured one, XRP. Sam made it clear that we don't offer any financial advice, but she personally likes to invest in silver any time she has some money spare. Recently XRP was only \$1, and it's now \$1.92 and likely to rise drastically once the financial reset happens. Sam gets physical bullion from Ainslie Bullion in Brisbane. (Ainsliebullion.com.au) as in-person, cash transactions have no digital footprint.

Court case

Mike's High Court case details were read out, giving us the background to the case.

We Are Change Brisbane created the lanyards with the Commonwealth logo on them.

Sign the Charter as a member.

Employers- Mike has placed a form on the download page. Ross is presently using this letter to his employer.

A doc that lists all the referendums that have ever happened in Australia. Only two were successful.

Records area

Record your live birth, property ownership etc. There is a list of records that you can register in common law. Lawful Rebellion if you wish to do so. There is also a medical marijuana section.

If you did a live birth previously and you didn't get a copy of your birth certificate, do it again and Sam will check and delete the previous copy.

Rebellion

Under the Magna Carta, we all have the right and duty to rebel if the government becomes destructive of our natural rights. We have become chattel and going in the wrong direction.

Meetings

Our meetings are monthly on the **second Sunday of the month**. We have the library room booked until October, except for September.

New Assemblies

Sam is stepping down as convenor of the Brisbane Central Assembly today and may be starting a Bribie Island Assembly. Also we could do with a Redcliffe Assembly. The Beachmere group hasn't taken off as planned.

Debt Eradication

Pam attended the last assembly at Bli Bli where Shane Beard spoke about debt eradication.

It's a 3-step process. She recommended attending the next Bli Bli assembly to learn more.

Shane has eradicated \$50k tax debt and \$20k credit card debt.

Fiona cautioned that if you're to go down this track, even though it's lawful and it works, you need to be sure to understand the process well.

Be impeccable with your words

Ross reminded us that when a person discriminates against us or trespasses us and they work for a store or corporation or service, you need to get their name, because when we bring them into our court processes, it is the person that we bring charges against-not the corporation.

Reminder – the government is a SERVICE. We are in power of them – they do not control us. This is common law basics. The preamble states, We the people, not we the corporation.

So when people say 'it's a company policy, *WHO MADE THE POLICY?* The corporation is a dead entity. PEOPLE made the rules.

Covid rules are NOT LAWS.

They aren't even gazetted. To be gazetted, laws need to pass through upper and lower house and be approved by the Governor General.

If anyone is pushing you to wear a mask – they can't. People listen to the media and are not thinking for themselves. Chief Medical Officer Jeanette Young said at a press conference that whilst it's great that people are wearing the masks, there is no need for anyone to enforce mask-wearing on others as some people have mask exceptions and they don't need to wear masks.

There was an incident that was presented to the Gympie CLC. A woman tried to enforce mask-wearing. The CLC member asked her name and she was reluctant. He got it all on camera. It might be a difficult challenge, but we have to do it. The woman will be charged with assault.

Another lady was abused at Bunnings. Under common law we charge the person, not the company.

More anecdotal evidence was given from attendees that showing staff the information from Jeanette Young is working to get staff to stop enforcing.

Insurance

Ross said he phoned his health insurance company and asked if he was covered if he takes the gene therapy injection. The guy had no idea what he was talking about, but when he worked out it was the covid jab he checked and came back and said they don't cover anyone who takes it, but Medicare does.

Aaron's insurance provider said they will cover, but that could be put to the test. You'd have to die to find out.

Australian Immunisation Register Cease and Desist document. [Australian Immunisation Register \(AIR\) – ceasing correspondence and release of information form \(IM017\) – Services Australia](#) Govt doc – says it stops third party information sharing and makes you ineligible for the vaccination

There was mention of the letter to the govt re the Immunisation Passport – objections closed the Wednesday following the meeting.

Be Free With Dee on Instagram – be careful with her forms.

How to Sign Documents

When signing any letters always sign to the right of the page (creditor) and always slightly over your written name, to eliminate the chance that your signature can be moved or altered.

Sign with red (creditor) or purple (sovereign) ink. Blue makes you the debtor.

Masks

Ross passed around a copy of a study that tells of the damage that masks can do.

It's called Masks, False safety and real dangers, Part 3: Hypoxia, hypercapnia and physiological effects.

Three Stop-All Letters

Doug spoke about and Fiona added information about the three letters that Fiona had told us about previously. Doug said if you haven't already sent your letters then you should do it now.

Purpose of the letters is to put them on notice that you will accept the vaccine on conditions.

It has a Joinder fee of \$2million if they bring a lawyer into the process.

It's a three-step process, and each letter has a certain waiting time before you send the next one.

1st letter 21 days

2nd letter 14 days

3rd letter 7 days.

Fiona is currently drafting a confirmation letter to send at the end of the seven days, to confirm that they have entered into the contract.

They need to be sent by registered mail. This will cost around \$200 all up.

If they send it back, then it sits in the post office, as it's Postal Fraud for the post office to not deliver it.

Doug is willing to set up the docs for you with your details, and date the envelopes etc so you know when to send them out. There are around 300 pages to be printed for all the letters, and Doug is willing to print them for members for around \$40 just to cover his costs. They have to be sent to thirteen people as instructed. The letters cover you, your spouse and children under 18 in the same household, but not family members living at other addresses.

Hint: Take screenshots of tracking process so you can prove later that it was delivered.

Doug's First Arrest

Doug told us how Reignite Democracy was the only group that really helped him when he was arrested. He said AdvocateMe (Serene Teffaha) fobbed him off. (Members in the assembly said Serene does have a lot on her plate, to be fair.) He said you really are on your own if you're arrested, and reminded us that THIS is your tribe and we the people, need to stick together and support each other. Reignite Democracy connected Doug to a lawyer who is confident of a good outcome for a charge of assault against the arresting police. (Rob Greely Lawyer)

Common Law Court

In CLC you represent yourself. No lawyers represent you. You may have one to confer with, but you speak for yourself. If you think you have a valid claim, consider it very carefully as claims are not taken lightly. You may submit a Statement of Claim using the commonlaw.earth website, where it will be reviewed. The CLC will decide if we should proceed. If it is considered a claim of merit, it then goes to mediation, then if the situation is not resolved, the person your claim is against will be summoned to the Common Law Court.

The Sunshine Coast Assembly has run three practice court sessions to get a really good understanding of the process and any improvements that members can learn for their own purposes. Other assemblies, including ours, can use this information for our own advantage.

Here's the kicker – 'They' aren't going to recognise the common law process until we get the numbers. So **we need to grow our numbers. It's in your best interest to invite, invite, invite.** We each should be bringing a new person to each meeting. Talk to your neighbours, talk to the shop attendant, hand out info, keep talking about common law.

Copyrighting your DNA

Fiona reiterated the information she'd given us previously. You can copyright your dna and the dna of your children.

Go to CopyrightClaimServices.com. Choose your certificate style, find your seals if you wish, then genetic code copyright. Only \$25 for copyright. Seal is extra. Once you own the copyright for your dna, ***your dna may not be taken*** (eg medical testing procedures like PCR), ***stored*** (eg Guthrie Card and other govt agencies) or ***shared***.

Get a JP to witness it.

Fiona is going to give us a time and date to host a Zoom meeting to guide people through the copyrighting process.

Fiona has also started a Family Book that stores all her family's records like Live Birth Certificate etc.

Promissory Notes

Be careful that you know what you're doing. Talk to Sheriff Shane Beard to gain a good understanding.

Trooth Network

Fiona will send a link to Trooth Network where she has created a channel just for us so we can join in the conversation with similar groups overseas. Trooth is owned by an Aussie living in the USA who runs a podcast called Troothiverse. Trooth is easy to use and Telegram seems to have some trolls going on there so Trooth might be more secure.

Vaccine Passports

Florida and Texas has said no to the passports. As soon as their restrictions were stopped their case numbers plummeted.

Blood Donors

It might be a bad idea to receive blood now. Our government does not allow blood storage. Blood only lasts 3 days. Most of our bloods historically have come from our elderly. Now our elderly have likely taken part in the medical trial of the mRNA jab. Japan has halted blood donorship from vaccinated persons, and they have mandatory vaccinations, so they won't have blood soon.

Hippocratic Oath

Since the 80s the oath no longer exists. Doctors no longer swear to uphold ethical standards – they can make any oath they wish, which could be ‘I swear to make lots of money’ if they so wish.

Vaccine

Shedding

Sam told us that Matt Lawson did a post about shedding. “Someone had had the second jab and I sat beside them. Three days later I was sick as a dog. I’ve been tested and told that I’m negative, but do I have some shit in my system?”

So now we need to stay clear of vaxxed people until we find out what’s going on.

Doctors say

We were told how someone who works in a hospital had a doctor tell them that he “wouldn’t touch this shit”. Medical professionals will be fined \$800 000 for speaking ill of the vaccine, and that explains why they’re going along with it.

The AstraZeneca vax is the chimpanzee one – it contains herpes. The doctor said that we will see an increase in herpes cancer within five years.

50% of the girls that got the Gardasil vax are now sterilized and some had to have their uterus taken. Three girls last week had to lose their throat (and had tracheotomy) during surgery for cervical cancer.

PCR

You can ask for a serology (blood) test instead of a PCR test. DNA harvesting is the most probable reason for the PCR tests.

The vaccine is to create a hyper-immune response so you will end up with autoimmune disorders.

We need to carry with us a document that says we don’t want blood donations, although medicos would likely ignore it.

Fiona does a lot of ‘cell saving’ for Jehovah’s Witnesses. Basically it’s a blood cleaning service instead of a transfusion. Blood cannot be collected and saved. Blood lost from a patient is sucked up and pumped through a salvage machine and

it gets pumped straight back in in a continuous flow. There needs to be minimum 500ml available to do it.

Civil Disobedience

Doug said that Stan, a retired Sergeant and Police Prosecutor said that if about 10% of people did this for parking fines and traffic infringements, then the system would collapse:

Do not accept the alleged offense. Dispute it and challenge it. Tell them you're going to defend it. They will have to prepare documents, but they won't do it. It's too time consuming.

Do not accept a court date. Ask for a new date that suits you. Do this every time they give you a date. Things come up. Use a different excuse each time.

Then you can appeal.

For a speeding offence, ask for a calibration of the equipment used to ascertain the speed you were doing. This is a costly exercise and they won't do it.

If it goes on for a year or more, then the 'offence' becomes invalid and it gets closed. Doug has shared this link for this on his googledrive so we can access it.

Vaccine Passport

You basically consented to this when you set up your MyGov account. Did you opt out of the myhealthrecord? It goes to Homeland Security and third parties.

MyGov will be used to trace and divide us. Get rid of it.

MyHealth records will eventually dictate who can get insurance. Also insurance companies won't cover you anyhow, so that's all going to end.

Police were all told to get rid of MyHealthRecord. Eventually nobody will have public health and only people with my health records will get private cover.

All the agencies are connected so anyone who works for one of them can access all your files.

Get rid of it. Delete all your records first, then disconnect each service, then delete the program.

Digital Warriors

Tania is our assembly co-ordinator of Marketing. Digital Warriors – all of us and our awakened friends – target one topic online per month.

Last meeting we decided that our target would be insurance companies and whether they will pay out after covid vax or not. This month we are targeting Vaccine Passport. “Lifting restriction of hydroxychloroquine and At time of writing the notes, members who attended have already received the information from Tania about this warrior project via an email from the assembly (Sam).

Be sure to send an individual email to each person on the list, because if you CC or BCC it will go into the spam folders.

New Convenor

Sam stepped aside due to moving to Bribie Island and Doug Walker was nominated as the new Convenor. He was congratulated and we wish him well and support him as our new Convenor.
