Important note

Failure to complete or update a register of interests can give rise to an offence, with associated penalties to a maximum of 85 penalty units, or 100 penalty units if a councillor intentionally fails to complete or update their register of interest, and/or disqualification from holding office as a councillor



for four years.

If you are unsure of your obligations with respect to registers of interest, it is strongly recommended that you seek independent professional advice to clarify your understanding of your obligations.
